## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CIYC BYLAWS

**3.7.1 DEBT OBLIGATIONS:** Annual dues or assessments are due and payable by January 31st and delinquent thereafter. However, a member may elect to pay one half of the dues on January 31st and pay the final installment by March 31st without being delinquent and without incurring any late payments. A member choosing to terminate their membership in the CIYC will be obligated for the full dues if notice of the election to terminate is not received by the treasurer of the CIYC by January 31. This section of the bylaws will be printed on the annual statement.

**3.7.4 FAILURE TO PAY INDEBTEDNESS:** Privileges of a member shall cease if the member's indebtedness has not been paid within sixty (60) days following mailing of a Notice of Delinquency by the club to the member's CIYC address of record and e-mailing to the member's CIYC e-mail address of record. It is the responsibility of each member of the club to keep the club informed of their correct mailing address and/or e-mail address.

### **ARTICLE 4: BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

**4.1 BOARD OF DIRECTORS:** The Board of Directors shall consist of up to Fourteen (14) members; Commodore, Vice Commodore, Rear Commodore, Fleet Captain, Port Captain, Junior Staff Commodore, Secretary, Treasurer, House Chairman, and five (5) Directors. All of these positions shall be held by Regular Members, in good standing. In the event that a board member holds more than one position, the total number of board members shall be reduced accordingly and each Director shall have only one vote regardless of the number of positions held.

**7.3: REAR COMMODORE:** The Rear Commodore shall assist the two Senior Officers in the discharge of their duties and, in their absence or disability, shall officiate in their stead. The Rear Commodore shall also supervise the Club Manager and shall be responsible for the activities of the Club Manager, and with the assistance of the Club Manager, for such other personnel as may from time to time be employed by the CIYC.

**7.3.1 HOUSE CHAIRMAN AND HOUSE COMMITTEE;** With the consent of the Board of Directors, the Rear Commodore shall appoint a House Chairman. The House Chairman shall, upon nomination by the Nominating Committee and election by the members, be a member of the Board of Directors and shall report to the Board of Directors. With the consent of the Board of Directors, the House Chairman shall select a house committee composed of the House Chairman, one (1) staff commodore, the Rear Commodore, the Fleet Captain, one (1) Board member at Large and two (2) regular members.

**10.1 HOUSE COMMITTEE:** The House Committee Chairman and House Committee shall be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the entire clubhouse and premises. Necessary expenditures shall require approval of the Board of Directors except as specified in House rules.
